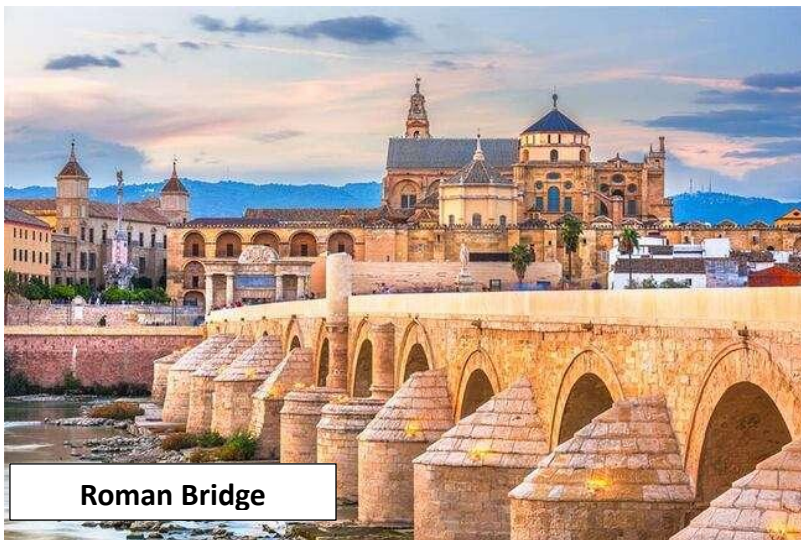

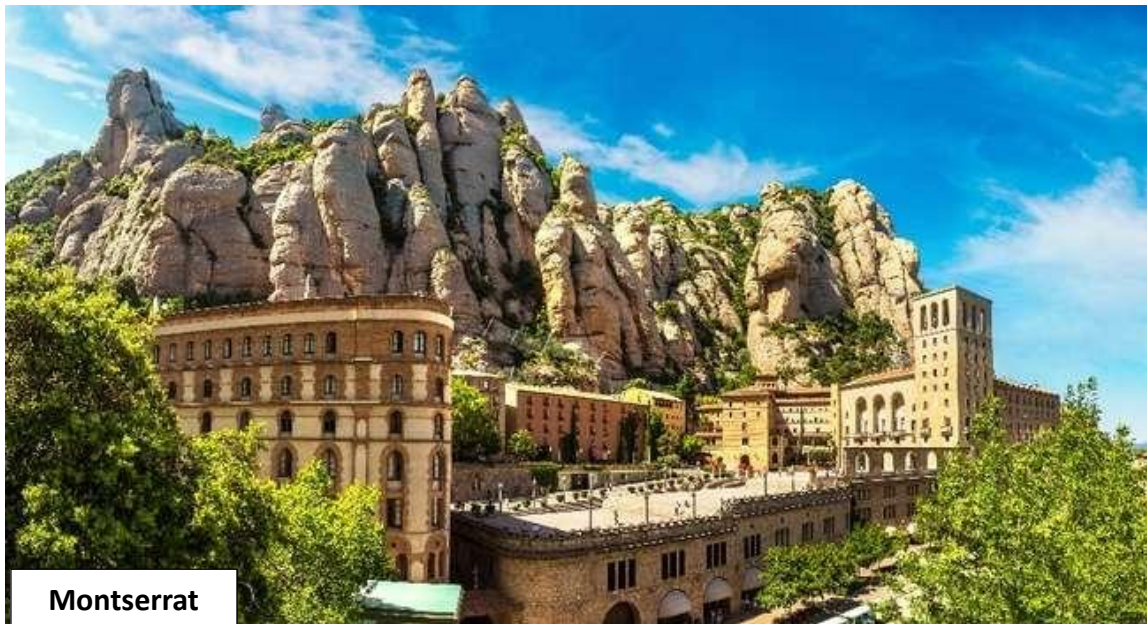
Overnight in Alicante / Valencia (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)
